In regard to the counselling on 4th June, 2017, candidates who have marks above 70 in SET, stand a chance of admission and are invited to attend counselling. The seats will be allotted to the candidates based on the merit in SET examination. The counselling/admission will start at 9.00 am. The reporting time for candidates falling in different marks ranges will be communicated in the next email on 22nd May, 2017.

Waitlist: If a candidate does not get a seat on the day of counselling, he/she can complete all formalities and give his/her name in the waitlist along with the choice of a branch. The candidates in the waitlist would be given admission as and when seats fall vacant. Our experience in the past has been that about 20-25% students vacate their seats and students from waitlist are given admission. If a student is given admission from the wait list, he/she doesn't need to come again personally, if he/she had attended the counselling. Those who are not able to attend the counselling on 4th June can also give their name in the waitlist by sending an e-mail to waitinglist@sitpune.edu.in (after June 4, 2017) along with a demand draft of Rs.1,22,500/- (returnable in case of no admission).

Hostel Accommodation: Those who need hostel accommodation will have to deposit a separate demand draft of Rs. 77,500/- for hostel facility, on the day of counselling.

The Institute does not take responsibility of ensuring admission to everyone who reports for counselling, as the seats will be allotted purely on merit.

You are advised to read the FAQs and counselling procedure carefully on www.sitpune.edu.in before coming for counselling.

We invite you to attend the counselling, enjoy our hospitality, see the facilities at the Institute and experience the beautiful weather of Pune. We will send you another mail few days before the counselling to give you more details of the process including transport arrangements.
